Distinction between light and dark, right and wrong

In a sense, this doesn't need to be said

Rom 2:15 "...the law is written on their hearts, while their conscience also bears witness, and their conflicting thoughts accuse or even excuse them..."

But in a day that there are those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness (Is 5:20), the truth needs proclaimed.

Abortion/trafficking; Trans agenda/"gender affirming care"/Pronouns;

New ageism; Witchcraft; Exultation of darkness; Sensuality/pornography;

Intimacy outside of marriage, as God defines it; Drunkenness;

Language; Gossip/slander; Deceit; Greed; Theft, Etc.

We are called to be separate

■ There is distinction between disciples of Jesus and those who are not.

Temple of God – one in whom the Holy Spirit of God dwells

o Eph 1:13-14

We are *in* the world, but not *of* the world (John 17:14-19). What does that mean for us?

• Must not support, affiliate with, or be silent regarding godlessness

- Not condemning, not 'holier than thou', but not unclear about sin
