To pierce through. To enforce. To instill by persistent instruction

* Note how deliberate that sounds?

"Talk about them..." in every aspect of life

While the phylacteries (little boxes containing these verses) became a literal response for the Jews, the word of God is to be ever before us.

It is to take center stage among the meditations of our hearts and is to be our daily source of direction.

MHAS

Those are supplements; not substitutes.
